COURSE OBJECTIVES: This course is designed to provide high quality, cost effective, didactic education to nurses (**recent graduates and licensed nurses**) who are **new** to the field of Obstetric and Newborn Nursing. It is intended to augment the hospital clinical orientation to the obstetrical and newborn units.

Basic course content includes pathophysiology, assessment, diagnostic techniques, care planning, medical and nursing therapeutics and evaluation of nursing care. Precepted perinatal clinical experience on non-class content days is encouraged for the successful application of class content. Competency of knowledge and skills is to be determined by participant's facility

OPQI is an approved provider of continuing education by the Western Multi-State Division, an accredited approver of continuing nursing education by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.

FACULTY: All classes will be taught by clinical experts from the Oklahoma Perinatal Nurses Forum hospitals and State and Local Health Departments representatives.
