- To foster a culture of collaboration, teamwork, patient safety, and communication between clinicians and patients to promote the Council's mission: safe health care for every woman.

# **ELIGIBILITY UPDATE**


# NIC is now open to ANY individual or team in the United States; not limited to educational programs!
