The Shared Planning Board is one of TeamBirth' Core Components. This means it is required for success, but it should be adapted to fit your unique context and needs. The shared planning board is a visual tool that:

- Structures huddle communication
- Provides space to document discussions during huddles in a way that is shared across the full team.

At a minimum, the board includes space for:

- 1. The Team
- 2. Patient Preferences
- 3. Care plans for mom, baby, and labor progress
- 4. The Next Huddle

With input from your teams, align on a shared understanding of:
